



1. PARTICIPANTS

All individuals who wish to participate in this photography contest (national and international) are welcome, whether they are professionals or amateurs, as long as their work adheres to the established guidelines.

2. THEME:

The themes of the photographic works must represent the fight against gender-based violence. They will be evaluated based on the following criteria:

- Notable personalities or activists in the fight against gender-based violence.
- Tribute to victims and orphans.
- Activities, campaigns, actions, or projects focused on real equality or aimed at eliminating structural violence against women.
- Raising awareness against all forms of gender-based violence that women experience in their environment, whether in the workplace, social settings, family, education, sports, etc.
- Reflecting or performing everyday situations that showcase gender-based violence.

Images from demonstrations, marches, or public spaces that violate the identity and privacy of individuals will be excluded.

3. CHARACTERISTICS OF THE PHOTOGRAPHS:

- Images must be original. They can be in color or black and white, but digital manipulation is not permitted.
- The minimum size of the original photographs must be 30x40 cm, and they should be presented without any type of mounting or support, in digital image format (JPG, PNG, RAW, etc.).
- Each participant may submit a maximum of 2 photographs. The content must be strictly related to the thematic criteria.
- The photographs must be the property of the author submitting them for this contest.

4. SUBMISSION AND SENDING METHOD

Submissions to the contest and the sending of photographs should be done via email to the following address: concursovalentina@ceuta.ccoo.es

Along with the images, the following personal information must be included:

PERSONAL INFORMATION:

- Full name of the author.
 - D.N.I / N.I.E or identification document number of the participants.
 - Country and locality of origin.
 - Address and contact phone number.
 - The email address used for participation and submission of images must belong to the participant.
 - Titles of the submitted works.
 - Number of the photograph.
- ❖ Declaration from the author regarding the authorization of the individuals appearing in the images (ANNEX I).



By participating in this contest, the author of the photographs grants permission for their exhibition and publication in any exhibitions and editions that take place.

5. SUBMISSION DATE

The participation period will be from October 18 to November 20, 2024.

6. JURY:

The jury will be appointed by the organization from individuals competent in the photographic and artistic fields. The jury reserves the right to interpret the rules of this contest and to resolve any cases not covered, according to their best judgment.

The results will be communicated via telephone or email to the awarded individuals.

The jury reserves the right to declare the awards void if the submitted works do not meet, in their opinion, the sufficient merits.

The jury will consist of:

The jury's verdict will be made public on November 22, 2024, and it will be final

7. PRIZES:

The following prizes are established:

- First prize: 300 €
- Second prize: 200 €
- Third prize: 100 €
 - No more than one prize can be awarded for the same photograph.
 - No more than one prize can be awarded to the same participant.
 - Awarded individuals who are local (Ceuta) commit to collecting the prize at the headquarters of Comisiones Obreras in Ceuta.
 - If the awarded individual is from any other location, the prize will be delivered via bank transfer.



- If the prize is awarded outside of Spanish territory, payment will be made through WESTERN UNION.

8. OBSERVATIONS:

The awarded works will become the property of the organization, which reserves all rights to them and may use them later for cultural, artistic, or advertising purposes, always citing the author's name, in accordance with the provisions of the Intellectual Property Law.

All submitted photographs must be free of rights from third parties.

Any photographs that do not meet the established requirements or the thematic criteria will be disqualified.

Participation in this Contest implies full acceptance of its Regulatory Bases.
